**Refunds:** Requested in writing (**email, fax or mail**) **ON or BEFORE** closing date will be honored less the office fee. **No refunds including stall fees for any reason after closing date. No changing of show dates after closing.**

**Times:** Will be posted on the web site ([www.silverwoodfarm.net](http://www.silverwoodfarm.net)) approximately one week prior to competition or entry must include SASE. Adequate time intervals cannot be guaranteed when rider enters multiple horses or if a horse has more than 1 rider. Riders will be notified via email when times are ready.

**Awards:** A prize will be awarded in all classes with 4 or more riders. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place for all classes.

**Dover Award** available at all shows. Class is 23A (second level test 3 adult) and is on Saturday.

**For Saturday ONLY**-A championship Ribbon and prize will be given to the horse and rider combination with the highest % (60% minimum) one test in the following divisions: USDF Intro, Jr/Yg Rider, Adult, Open (Training-First), All divisions combined (2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>), and FEI. Kurs are NOT Eligible. High points will be awarded on Sunday. Riders must pick all prizes and tests at the show.

**Stabling:** 10x10 permanent with doors in the stabling complex, 12x12 with doors in the main barn. When main barn is filled or not available, request will be reassigned to stabling complex. Temporary stall will be used ONLY if necessary. Shavings are \$7 per bag (bedding **NOT** included) and orders must be received with entry or by 2:00 pm each day. Competitors responsible for stall damage

**Silverwood Championships Series Rules October 16-17 2010**

- 1) Championship will be determined by the average of the-three top scores-earned at the highest test of the level by the same horse/rider combination. The average will be calculated on this combination.
- 2) Two of the three scores must be earned from two different judges at any two dressage competitions at Silverwood during the current year. These scores must be from the highest test of the level, not including Introductory Level which may be either test A or B.
- 3) The third score is to be earned in the Championship ride during the Dressage at Silverwood October 16-17 show.
- 4) Entrant must submit the prerequisite copies of their two highest score sheets with their show entry. These will be the scores used in the Championship calculations.
- 5) Championship rides will be the highest test of the level. Introductory Championship will be test B.
- 6) Tests may be read (to 4th level) and whips are allowed.
- 7) Introductory Level Championship will be two divisions -Horse or Rider. introductory level riders cannot cross enter these divisions. All other tests will be based on designated divisions and nders will not cross enter divisions.
- 8) Awards: Champion trophy and championship ribbons to 6th place.
- 9) USEF and USDF rules and membership requirements are enforced.
- 10) Classes may be used for 2010 Qualifying (add \$10 to Champ. Class fee)

**USEF Membership Statement**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**Motorized Vehicle Statement**

In accordance with GR1301.7:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Sharps Container Statement**

In accordance with GR1210.4

Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition. If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. Competitions failing to comply with placing the required number of containers on the show grounds will be considered in violation of the rules and may be subject to penalty as determined by the CEO or Executive Director and/or the Hearing Committee. 5.
